- 1. Work continues on the damaged structures at the Baseball and Softball fields. The girls' home dugout and press box is all but completed along with the concession building and restrooms at the softball field. At the Baseball field, the visitor and home dugout slabs have been poured and the laying of blocks should be completed by the first of the year. The backstop support poles have also been erected. Work is scheduled to continue through the holidays and facilities will be ready for the beginning of the seasons. Miller Roofing is scheduled to be back on campus during the holidays to continue roof repairs at the Tech Center. All insurance monies have not been received, but Gov. Riley sent us \$10,000 to use with the recovery cost from the tornado. We are very appreciative to Gov. Riley for this aid.**
